Amen.

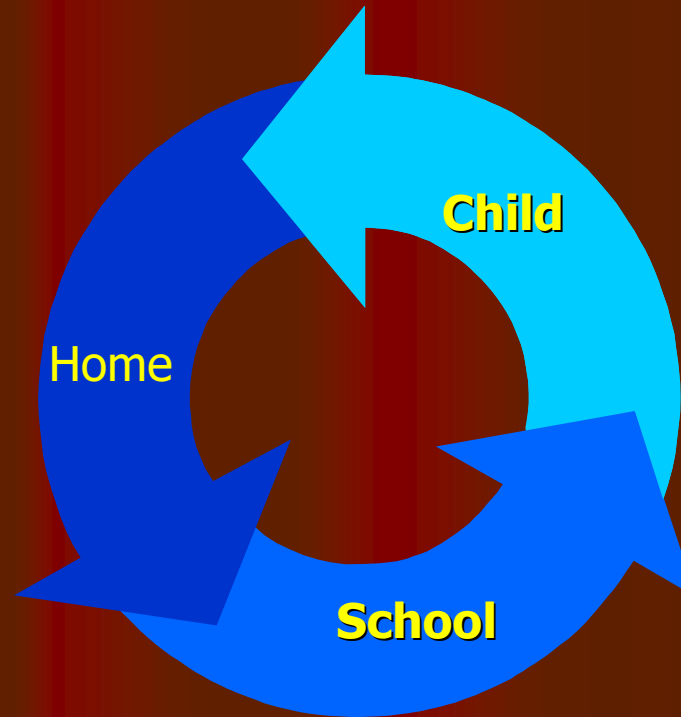

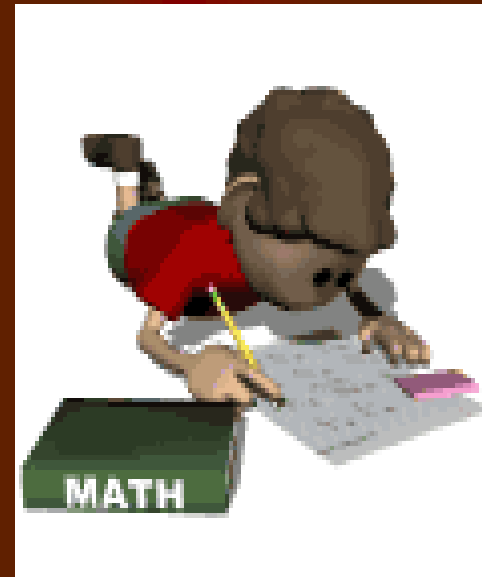
